It tells the public that you and your employees are a stable legitimate company. It tells them you have passed a background check, have insurance, and you continue to receive education in an ever changing industry. This doesn't mean much if your customer does not know you are licensed. No one is in better position to educate the public than our members. The DPS is doing all they can to get unlicensed individuals. There will always be handy men and unlicensed individuals flying under the radar. The will not catch all of

them. I tell all my customers we are licensed to do their work. Make sure whoever they hire has license. Show them your pocket card. Tell them all licensees must carry with them whenever working and ask to see it. If they do have a locksmith show up and refuse to produce their card, they should ask them to leave. If they have any problem they should call the police immediately. Never pay these guys in cash. Public awareness will do more for our profession than any DPS officer can do.

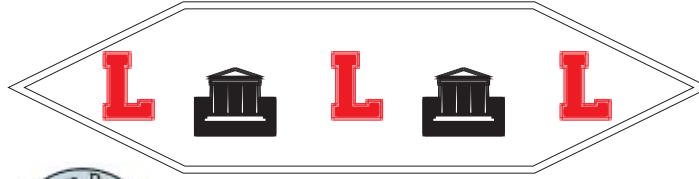

## OCTOBER 2008 DPS / PSB BOARD MEETING REPORT

This was the proposed exemption for **handymen** to install a lock the customer bought at mass merchandiser.

***A Special Thank You to Bonnie Morse, Editor of LASA for this report.....***

I was glad to see at least 15 Locksmiths in attendance at the Quarterly PSB Board Public meeting today! TLA Board was well represented along with LASA, ALNT, GHLA, & ALOA. A gathering of security industry representatives also meet on Wednesday evening for discussion and I was glad to learn TLA (locksmiths) was included in the meeting.

Thank you each and every Locksmith which took the time to write a letter of concern to the DPS/PSB Board. They did indeed receive 'buckets and buckets' of mail. The proposed rule addition under 35.311 EXEMPTIONS (concerning unlicensed folks installing locksets or hardware) was sent to committee. This means we need to stay alert, but the committee is aware of your concerns and we will not see anything more until at least January 2009. There were a few other items of interest to the locksmith discussed. There is a 'pilot program' underway regarding 'termination of company employees'. This would allow a clear path to who works for who when across the security industry. Some concerns in using the online registration for individuals, a suggestion of 'temporary ID cards', and concerns about the telephone/web listings under bogus addresses or unlicensed security companies were reported during public comment. Some 20 people/companies were each addressed by the Board during the Administrative Hearing.

The next DPS/PSB Board Public meeting is expected to be scheduled in late January 2009.

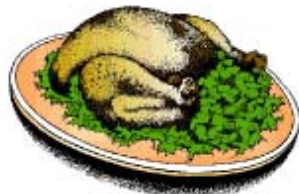
